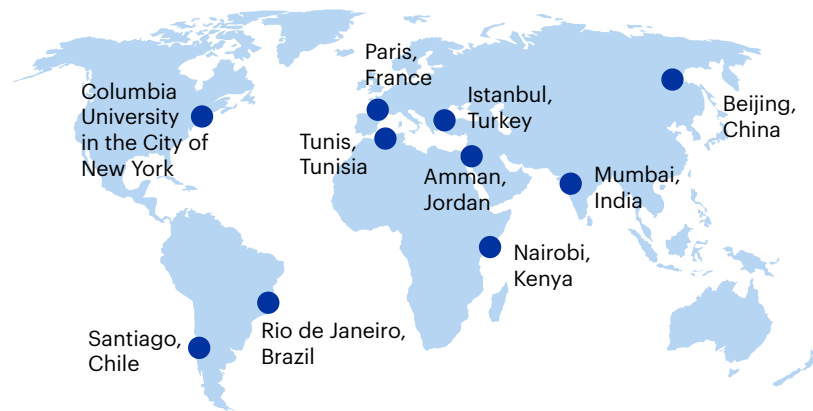

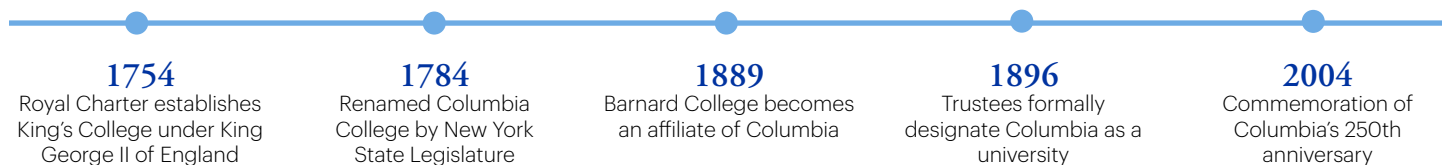

Timeline



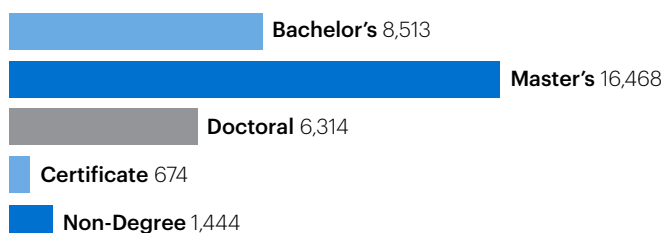

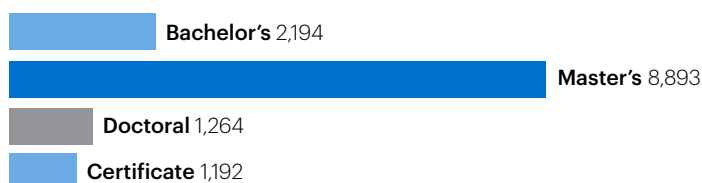

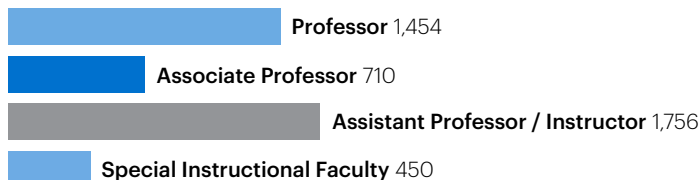

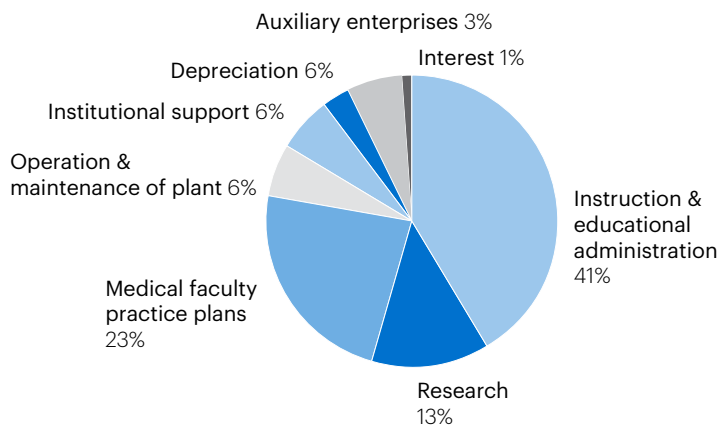
