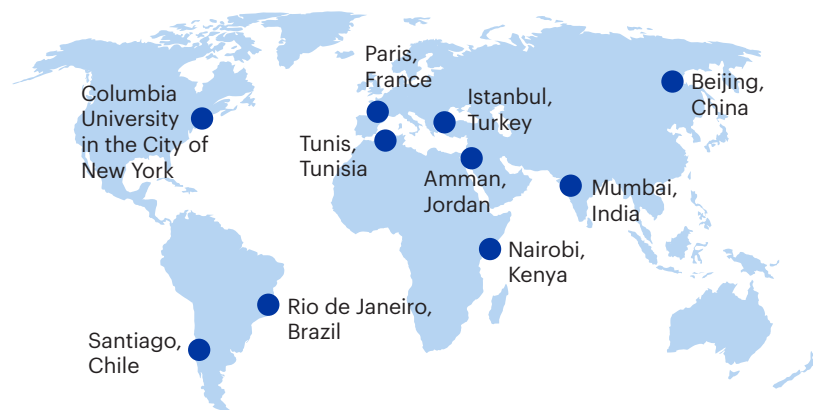

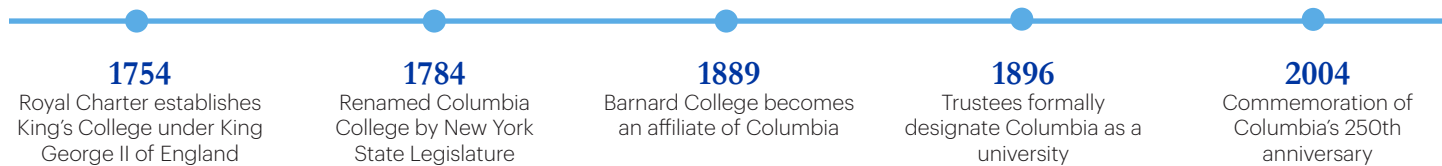

Timeline



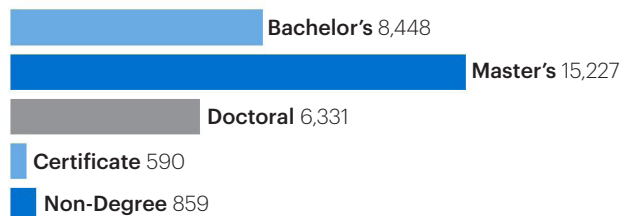

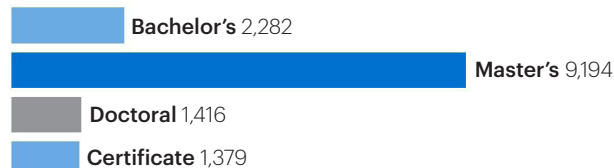

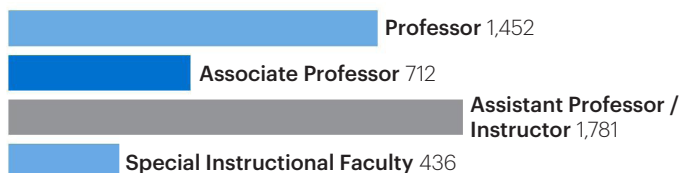

Full-time Staff Size (Fall 2020)

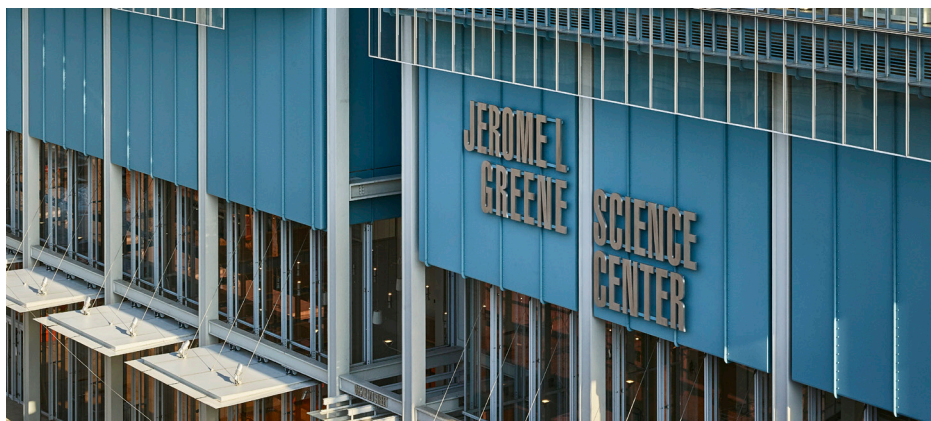

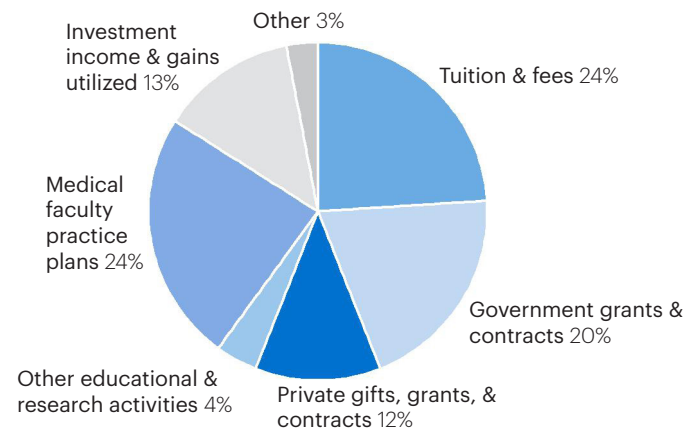

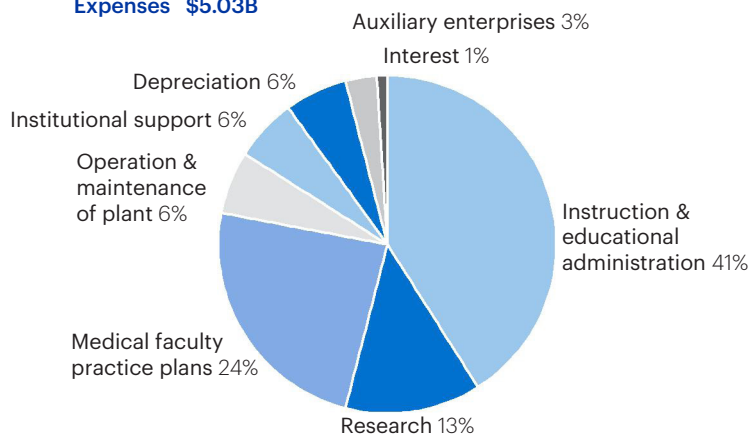
