



Columbia University Libraries is a globally-recognized academic research library, serving one of the world's most important centers of research and learning. The Libraries employs more than 400 staff and student assistants and hosts over 2.5 million physical and over 6.5 million virtual visitors each year. The collections include over 15 million volumes, with access to over 7 million online electronic resource titles, nearly 300,000 linear feet of manuscripts and archives, over 150,000 maps, and over 1.2 million graphic and audio-visual materials. Through an extensive global network of library partnerships, Columbia Libraries also facilitates access to collections at academic, research, and public libraries across the country and the world.


