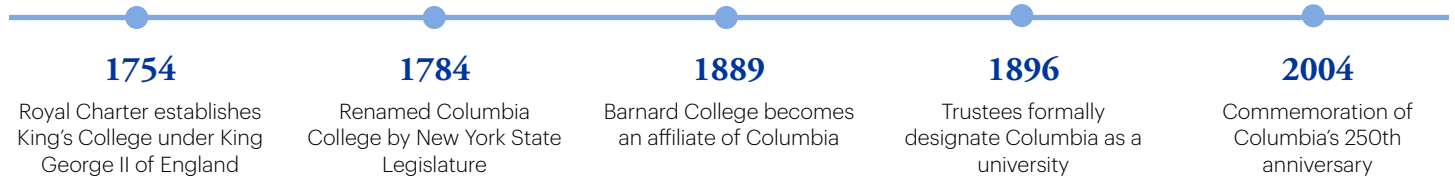

Timeline



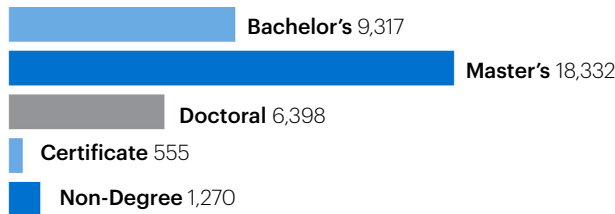

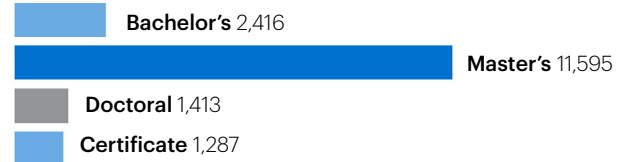

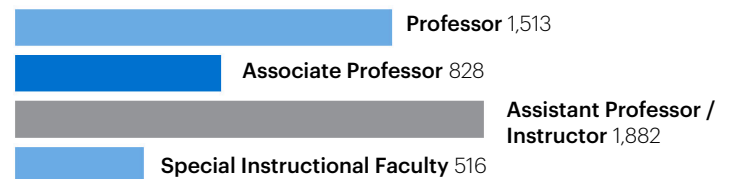

Libraries

Columbia University Libraries is a globally-recognized academic research library, serving one of the world's most important centers of research and learning. The Libraries employs more than **400** staff and student assistants and hosts over **2.5 million** physical and over **6.5 million** virtual visitors each year. The collections include over **15 million** volumes, with access to over **7 million** online electronic resource titles, nearly **300,000** linear feet of manuscripts and archives, over **150,000** maps, and over **1.2 million** graphic and audio-visual materials. Through an extensive global network of library partnerships, Columbia Libraries also facilitates access to collections at academic, research, and public libraries across the country and the world.

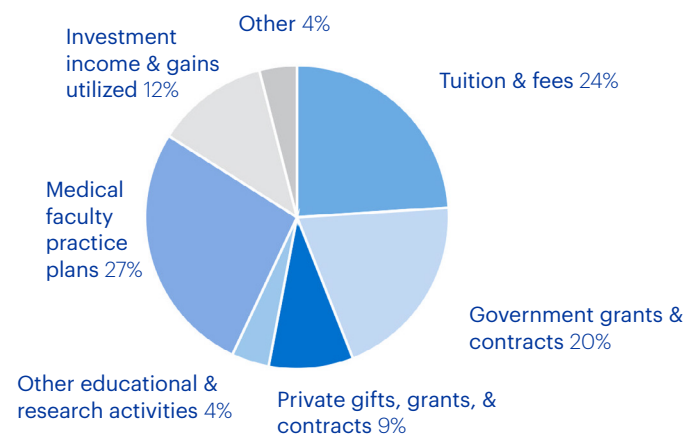

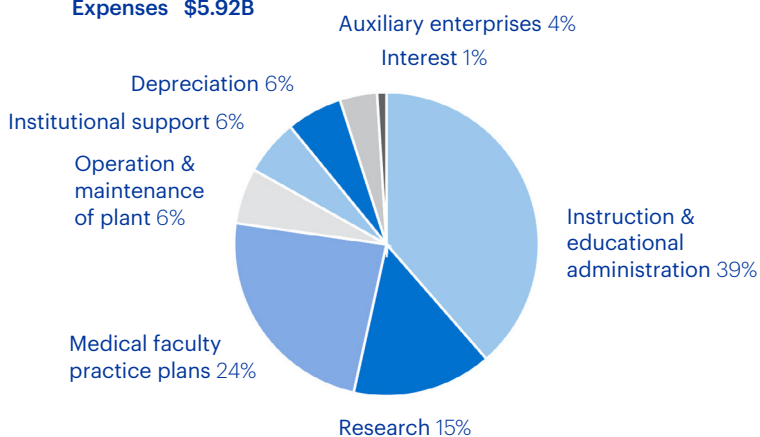
