- Excludes students from Barnard College, Teachers College, and those participating in Auditing and Pre-College Programs.
- Undergraduate nursing students reported under School of Nursing (last enrolled in AY 2015-16).
- Global Program students are non-Columbia students enrolled in Columbia-led global programs.
- Enrollments as of mid-October (Fall 2024 as of 10-18-2024).
- Accounts for withdrawals entered into Student Information Systems prior to early November (Fall 2024 as of 11-1-2024).
- Students are reported in the schools which administer their programs.

For Fall 2021 only:

- Columbia College enrollments include 64 visiting students
- Undergraduate Engineering enrollments include 5 visiting students
- General Studies enrollments include 5 degree-seeking students enrolled only in zero-credit classes and 101 non-degree students
- General Studies enrollments include 358 students participating in International Dual Degree Programs and 297 students enrolled in the Postbac Premed Program
- Morningside Graduate School enrollments include 385 visiting students, 247 non-degree students, and 156 certificate of professional achievement students
- Medical Center Graduate School enrollments include 88 visiting students, 142 non-degree students, and 9 certificate of professional achievement students

For Fall 2022 only:

- Columbia College enrollments include 74 visiting students and 42 study abroad students
- Undergraduate Engineering enrollments include 4 visiting students, 6 study abroad students, and 1 non-degree student
- General Studies enrollments include 6 study abroad students, 1 degree-seeking student enrolled only in zero-credit classes, and 81 non-degree students
- General Studies enrollments include 373 students participating in International Dual Degree Programs and 232 students enrolled in the Postbac Premed Program
- Morningside Graduate School enrollments include 365 visiting students, 14 study abroad students, 305 non-degree students, and 149 certificate of professional achievement students
- Medical Center Graduate School enrollments include 182 visiting students, 181 non-degree students, and 23 certificate of professional achievement students

For Fall 2023 only:

- Columbia College enrollments include 60 study abroad students
- Undergraduate Engineering enrollments include 5 study abroad students
- General Studies enrollments include 6 study abroad students, 2 non-credit-seeking degree-seeking students, 345 students participating in International Dual Degree Programs, and 68 non-credit-seeking students enrolled in the Postbac Premed Program
- Morningside Graduate School enrollments include 19 study abroad students, 59 non-credit-seeking non-degree students, and 3 non-credit-seeking certificate of professional achievement students
- Medical Center Graduate School enrollments include 19 non-credit-seeking non-degree students
- Special Programs enrollments include 7 non-credit-seeking non-degree students

For Fall 2024 only:

- Columbia College enrollments include 42 study abroad students.
- Undergraduate Engineering enrollments include 7 study abroad students.
- General Studies enrollments include 4 study abroad students, 3 non-credit-seeking degree-seeking students, 330 students participating in International Dual Degree Programs, and 84 non-credit-seeking students enrolled in the Postbac Premed Program.
- Morningside Graduate School enrollments include 31 study abroad students, 54 non-credit-seeking non-degree students, and 2 non-credit-seeking certificate of professional achievement students.
- Medical Center Graduate School enrollments include 22 non-credit-seeking non-degree students.
- Special Programs enrollments include 17 non-credit-seeking non-degree students.
